Two new restaurants and a salon are among the latest additions to The Plaza at 2534 in Johnstown.

Chrisland Inc., developer of 2534, announced restaurants Bonefish Grill and Spicy Pickle as well as Impact, a Salon Experience, will join The Plaza at 2534, southeast of the Interstate 25 and U.S. 34 interchange, this summer.

"We like the mix (of businesses), and feel like we need a mix for residents and businesses," said Nick Christensen, managing

All three businesses are under construction, and slated to open this summer, Christensen said.

Florida-based Bonefish Grill is a seafood restaurant that specializes in various species of oven-grilled fish.

It will be Bonefish's first Northern Colorado restaurant, and third statewide.

Spicy Pickle is a sandwich shop offering more than 150,000 sandwich combinations, along with specialty panini sandwiches.

The Loveland location will be the 22nd Spicy Pickle in Colorado.

Impact, a Salon Experience, is a locally owned high-end hair salon, Christensen said.

The center is already home to Starbucks, Eheart Interior Solution, and a four-story multi-tenant building, already open.

Opening soon will be Ethan Allen, Verizon Wireless and Culver's Frozen Custard and Butterburgers.

The Plaza at 2534 contains more than 500,000 square feet of planned retail, and 100,000 square feet of office.
