

Loveland Waffle House to be Teriyaki Planet

LOVELAND - The former Waffle House restaurant in Loveland will soon be converted into Teriyaki Planet.

The building, located at 1421 E. Eisenhower Blvd., was sold on Jan. 14 for \$555,000 to Soon B. Kim and Jae Youn Kim, who have run the Teriyaki Bowl in Greeley for the past 16 years. The sale was brokered by Chrisland Commercial Real Estate Inc. in cooperation with Century 21 Humpal Inc. The Loveland Waffle House site was sold just two days after the Fort Collins Waffle House location, which will become a Mad Greens restaurant.

Teriyaki Planet is expected to be open by the end of February. The menu features "fresh, healthy Asian food including teriyaki beef and chicken, most often served with steamed vegetables on a bed of rice," according to a release announcing the sale. Long-term plans for the business include expansion.
